Supplies

Pen points:

Leonardt Principal (John suggests this nib, but any of the following or your favorite will do)

Tachikawa G

Zebra G

Hunt 101

(crow quills are not suitable for Madarasz Script)

Oblique penholders:

Right oblique holders are to be used by right and left handers.

What ever you use for copperplate should work for Madarasz Script as well.

Be sure that the flange is adjustable or is set at a slight upward cant.

(Speedball plastic holders are not good for Madarasz Script)

Inks:

Preferred ink: McCaffery's Penman's Ink, preferably black for practice

Also: Old World Ink and Iron Gall ink.

Sumi and Ziller inks need water added for finer hair lines

Paper:

Claire Fontaine and Rhodia are best but expensive for practice.

John uses Ink Jet paper, Hammermill or Staples brand.

Misc.:

Cushion: use about 6 pages of newspaper under your writing paper

Wet sponge

Loose leaf note book or other to hold your handouts
